

## Khiraule Education and Health Project

Lhakpa Sherpa and his wife Pat (our Chair and Secretary and cofounders of KEHP) took 10 Trekkers up to Khiraule in November 2014 to see the progress on our building project and to take part in some of the work. A tremendous amount had been achieved since KEHP's building work commenced in May 2014 on four additional classrooms and a room for a clinic. In April 2015 when Lhakpa return all the work had been completed including the extra toilets, wall display boards, playground levelling, and a supply of drinking water, all funded by Rotary International. ### **Building Work**

This extensive building work was done by the local people of Khiraule. This is a tremendous achievement in such a remote area, where everything has to be carried and done by hand, as it is many days walk to the nearest road and there is no electricity in Khiraule. KEHP are most appreciative of all their hard work and time. None of this would have been possible without the work of the two Project Supervisors Gombu Sherpa and Jangbu Sherpa who did a remarkable job ensuring both Projects were done efficiently and effectively. A huge Thank You goes to both of them from KEHP. Also KEHP are indebted to our Chair Mr Lhakpa Sherpa without whom none of this work would have been possible. He has done an incredible job in organising, running, and ensuring work on both projects has been done to a high standard and within an extremely good timescale.



KEHP are most grateful to the following for their contributions towards the cost of the building work: Rotary Club of Kendal, The Quakers of Acomb York, and a bequest from the late Ellie Maquire, together with considerable donations from our many supporters.

Everyone was overwhelmed at the tremendous welcome they received from the people of Khiraule. All the children, teachers, and parents were delighted with the support they have received from KEHP and put on a fabulous welcome party of Sherpa and Nepali dance and song together with a very moving farewell ceremony at the school.



Kendal Rotary Club and District Rotary, led by Philip Hoyle, also provided money for various items the School Committee identified were needed. These were taken up to Khiraule and presented to the School. Please see the photos on our website.

Kathmandu Thamel Youth Rotary Club led by Tshering Sherpa collected a considerable amount of second hand books and sports equipment for the new school library and sports. This was also presented to the school staff who were most grateful for this contribution.

Many porters were needed to carry all this equipment up to the school for five days, trekking up and down very strenuous steep ascends and descends.

In addition we fund 4 teachers at the school to supplement those funded by the Nepal Education Authority.

### **The Clinic**

The Clinic room has now been built and KEHP will buy equipment for it and aim to fund the training for an Assistant Nurse Midwife, and pay the annual salary. This is financially supported by Morecombe Soroptomists, the Leeds "Rock for Nepal" Group, and a bequest by the late Richard Crossley, OBE, as well as KEHP.

## **Earthquake Update**

The KEHP building work and Rotary International Project was completed five days before the earthquake struck Nepal on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2015, with all its horrific consequences for Nepal and so many people across Nepal. Many schools in Nepal have been badly damaged or totally

destroyed. However, Khiraule school is still able to operate though slightly damaged. The room for the Clinic has not been damaged.

Khiraule was very fortunate as no one in the village has been injured but sadly two young climbing Sherpas from the village died on Everest when the avalanche of ice and rock hit base camp. Many of the houses in Khiraule are now uninhabitable due to large cracks making them unsafe to live in, with others damaged requiring urgent assessment of what assistance is needed. Lhakpa was in Kathmandu when the earthquake struck and was able to get sufficient



tarps for Khiraule from different sources in Kathmandu. He arranged for them to be transported to the road head, from where five Sherpas had to carry them for three days over mountainous terrain up to Khiraule. The monsoon has started but thankfully they now all have adequate shelter.

After the monsoon in October it will be possible to start assisting the people in Khiraule to rebuild their houses.

We are in the process of adding a new 'objective' to our constitution to enable us to assist with the earthquake relief in Khiraule. We have been fund raising and have been overwhelmed by people's kindness and generosity at this very difficult time for Nepal and in particular Khiraule.

We wish to thank all those who have supported KEHP over the years and enabled us to build the Lower Secondary School, a Clinic Room, and fund four teachers a year. This achievement shows how successful we are at getting things done for Khiraule and we are committed to aim to do the same to help people in Khiraule rebuild their houses. Please note we have no administration costs and all the money raised goes to Khiraule. All flights from the UK to Nepal are done at the individual's own expense.

2. To equip the new clinic, train an Assistant Health Worker, and pay the annual salary for the AHW.
3. To assist the people of Khiraule with repair and/or rebuild of their houses due to the damage caused by the recent earthquakes.
4. To repair and/or rebuild earthquake damaged walls on the older part of the school.
